


## ProDVX GM-75 Glass Mount




## ProDVX GM-75 Glass Mount

instruction manual

Thank you for choosing the ProDVX GM-75 Glass Mount. This is a step by step instruction manual to successfully install the ProDVX GM-75 Glass Mount for you 10" display.

The ProDVX GM-75 Glass Mounts contains the following parts:









- 1 x 10" foil / sticker
- 1 x U-frame (8 x VESA holes)
- 1 x centre block
- 1 x sheet with 2 adhesive strips
- 4 x short VESA screws (M412)
- 1 x security screw (cross-recess)



1) Clean the surface with Pro-Screen Cleaner spray



2) Place the foil with the desired size on the glass surface



3) Hold the foil on the left side and pull the backside paper out





4) Use a solid straight item to even out the foil




5) Even out big bubbles with the straight item (little bubbles will disappear with time)





- 6) Gently pull down the paper from the frontside
- 7) Clean the silver foil/sticker with Pro-Screen Cleaner spray and let it dry for 3 minutes.



8) Add the adhesive strips on the backside of the centre block where 7.65 mm is mentioned, and **firmly press** the sticking tape onto the backside of the centre block.





- 9) Slide the centre block with the 2 adhesive strips into the U-frame.
- 10) Screw the U-frame with the centre block in it, on the back of the ProDVX display using the 4 VESA screws




11) Remove the tape from the 2 adhesive strips



12) To align the display with the silver sticker; hold the display level in front of the sticker. When aligned; push the display gentle onto the silver sticker and make sure the centre block sticks to the sticker.




- 13) Remove the display (with u-frame) by sliding it to the top and **firmly press** the adhesive centre block in the middle of the foil and let the centre block rest for 3 minutes.
- 14) Slide the ProDVX display top-down on to the centre block



15) Use a Phillips screwdriver to tighten the long security screw on top





16) The ProDVX GM-75 Glass Mount is now successfully installed
