### Enhanced Security by Design

Our devices now support Android Verified Boot (AVB), meeting the latest electrical safety requirements. Each ProDVX device is securely signed during manufacturing, ensuring that only verified and genuine ProDVX firmware can be installed. This provides stronger protection against unauthorized software and tampering.

### Improved Device Security Defaults

To further enhance out-of-the-box security, USB debugging is now disabled by default.

### Smarter Network Integration

With LLDP negotiation support, devices can now automatically exchange network information, simplifying deployment and network management.

### Updated Web Experience

The Web Viewer and Chromium have been updated to version 142, delivering improved performance, stability, and compatibility with modern web applications.

### Latest Android Security Updates

This release includes the Android 13 security patch dated December 5, 2025, keeping devices protected against the latest vulnerabilities.

### More Flexible Device Configuration

Startup configuration has been expanded, allowing more settings to be defined via a JSON file. This enables faster provisioning and greater consistency across deployments, including control over new parameters:

- Enable or disable System bars
- Display Orientation
- Enable or Disable HDMI-out
- Device name
- LED controller type
- Physical screen size
- Brightness level
- Dark theme
- Pogo Camera or USB camera mounting position
- Camera mirror

- Font size
- Display size
